Day 1

LONDON - GLASGOW

Your luggage is packed and ready to go. All you have to do is meet at your designated pick-up location, where you will be greeted and escorted onboard. We will then leave London early in the morning and begin our long drive north, where you will sit back and relax in our comfortable coach until we arrive at our first destination, the Sri Venkateswara Balaji Temple in Birmingham. You will have the opportunity to say your prayers here.

We will be traveling through Cumbria's Lake District National Park on this trip. Following our prayers, we will depart to the north, where you will be able to enjoy the scenic views and take panoramic stills on your camera while we travel. As we drive through the Lake District, we can admire the park's lakes, towns, villages, and mountains. Enjoy a 45-minute boat cruise from Bowness-on-Windermere once we arrive at Lake Windermere.

You will then return to the coach at the designated time, and we will depart for Glasgow (Scotland). We will travel along one of the most scenic and beautiful routes in the Lake District, giving us the opportunity to see the Kirkstone Pass, a mountain pass in the Lake District with an elevation of 1,489 feet (454 m), and Ullswater Lake, the second

largest lake in the Lake District, which will accompany us for approximately 14.5 kilometres. We'll then take the motorway to Glasgow, passing through Gretna Green.

As we approach the Scottish border, we will stop in Gretna to visit the famous Black Smith shop, where in the past the Black Smith assisted all runaway couples in getting married and escaping Scotland. This venue is now a world-famous destination for traditional weddings and a tourist attraction. When you arrive, take your time exploring the venue and, if you're lucky, you might catch a wedding in progress. You will then return to the coach at the specified time, and we will depart for Glasgow.

After the fantastic voyage of our first day and knowing each other very well, we will head for our dinner at an Indian restaurant where an irresistible and delicious feast will be waiting for you. After dinner, we will travel to our hotel, where you will spend the night relaxing and preparing for the day's activities.

Day 2

GLASGOW - LOCH LOMOND - FORT WILLIAMS, NEVIS RANGE - FORT AUGUSTUS - GLASGOW

After early breakfast, we depart towards Highland to view the magnificent mountains and lake scenery. En-route we take a photo-stop at Loch Lomond, one of the prettiest and largest Lochs in the whole of Scotland. We then visit the infamous site of the 1692 Glencoe massacre one of the most famous Glens, where we pause for a photo-stop and to soak up the atmosphere in that haunting Glen. Later continue our journey to Fort Williams for the Nevis Range. En-route, enjoy beautiful views of the nature as we arrive to the Nevis Range. On arrival at the Nevis Range, enjoy the summit of the Nevis Range by its Gondola (Cable Car). On your return, we will continue to Fort Augustus, which is a town on the shores of the world famous Loch Ness, home to the mysterious legend of Nessie, the Loch Ness Monster. After our visit to the Loch Ness, we will start our descend from the highlands of Scotland and return back to Glasgow. On arrival enjoy dinner and retreat to our hotel.

Day 3

GLASGOW - EDINBURGH - GLASGOW

After breakfast, we depart for day trip to explore the capital city of Scotland - Edinburgh. As it says the name is enough, everyone knows that Edinburgh is the most historical town of Scotland. En-route we take a photo-stop at Falkirk Wheel, which is a rotating boat lift in Tamfourhill, Falkirk, in central Scotland, connecting the Forth and Clyde Canal with the Union Canal. You will then return to the coach at your given time and we will depart for another photo-stop known as The Kelpies, the world's largest equine 30-metre-high horse-head sculptures depicting kelpies, located between Falkirk and Grangemouth, standing next to a new extension to the Forth and Clyde Canal, and near River Carron, in The Helix. You will then return to the coach at your given time and we will depart for Edinburgh, on arrival enjoy a panoramic tour with stops at the Holyrood Palace, the Scot-tish residence of Her Majesty the Queen and the Scottish Parliament, Scottish National Gallery, St. Giles Cathedral, Edinburgh Castle,, Royal Mile and later on you will be given the free time to explore the city at your own pace. At your given time we will start our return journey to Glasgow, In the evening enjoy dinner and return to our hotel.
